



Holy Week Activities for Children

Day 6

RESURRECTION

ACTIVITY 1

YOU'LL NEED:

- Empty Easter eggs

Typically, we have Easter egg hunts where kids find eggs filled with candy inside them. Hide some Easter eggs and instruct your kids to go and find them, but tell them not to open them until all are found.

Have them come together and recap the Easter story. Then have them open their eggs. They will be disappointed, but explain to them that the people who found Jesus' tomb empty, probably felt the same way. Discuss why Jesus died and what his death has done for us.

ACTIVITY 2

YOU'LL NEED:

- Colored tissue or construction paper
- Clear tape
- Scissors
- Cutouts of a cross, a fish, a heart, or a crown
- Glue sticks

Have kids choose a cut out and add glue to it. Tear small pieces of tissue paper and overlap them to cover the top of their cutout. When the surface is covered completely, they can let it dry.

If using the clear adhesive, have kids put the sticky side up and cover it with tissue paper. They can add another layer of adhesive over their creation if they wish.
